Program Objectives:

- To protect and promote the quality of surface water;
- To provide a natural way of reducing run-off from roof-tops, lawns and driveways
- To promote bioretention, removing pollutants from storm water and restoring natural infiltration.

Eligibility:

- The registered landowner must make out all applications;
- There is no limit to the number of applications that a landowner can make to this program; and
- The rain garden must be located within Urban Communities.

Incentive:

- The Turtle Mountain CD will pay 75% of project costs up to a maximum of \$2000 per project, provided that the project received a successful final site visit and inspection.

Application deadline: This application must be completed and received by **June 30 annually**. Late or incomplete applications will not be accepted.

TERMS AND CONDITIONS

General Terms and Conditions:

- The annual projects resulting from this program are subject to funds appropriated; and
- All projects must be approved by the TMCD board prior to construction and/or installation.
- Failure of a landowner to meet Landowner Responsibilities may negate him / her from other Conservation District programs.

The Landowner shall:

1. Complete a Rain Garden Worksheet including details on design and construction;
2. Maintain the rain garden for a minimum of five years after construction;
3. Not begin building the rain garden before receiving approval of participation by the TMCD;
4. Indemnify and save harmless the TMCD, their agents, engineers, servants, and/or employees from any liability which may result from this project.
5. Provide access for inspection or evaluation by TMCD Staff or Board when requested
6. Consent to the TMCD establishing appropriate signage for the project if desired; and

The Turtle Mountain Conservation District shall:

1. Provide guidance and expertise regarding design and construction plans;
2. Conduct a preliminary site visit prior to construction, as well as a final site visit after project is complete;
3. Reimburse the landowner 75% of project costs to a maximum of \$2000 per project, provided that the project received a successful final site visit and inspection.
4. Retain the option to erect signage promoting the Rain Garden Program.

I hereby declare that I have read the conditions of the Rain Garden Program and that I agree to abide by this agreement; and that I agree to co-operate to the fullest extent with the Turtle Mountain Conservation District #4 in completing and maintaining the project as outlined above.
