



Remote Watering System Program Application Form

Program Objectives:

- To improve the quality of water provided to livestock through the use of remote watering systems (i.e. shallow burial pipelines, solar-powered pumps, wind-powered pumps, gas powered pumps etc.);
- To protect surface water quality;
- To promote the importance of water quality;
- To reduce the loss of livestock by eliminating access to water sources; and
- To protect fish and wildlife habitat.

Eligibility:

- The registered landowner or renter must make out all applications; and
- Location of remote watering system must be within the Turtle Mountain Conservation District
- System must be situated near a natural waterbody.
- One system per farm location.

Project Funding/Cost-sharing:

- The Turtle Mountain CD may pay 100% of the total project cost up to a **maximum of \$5,000** for summer watering systems or 50% up to a maximum \$5000 for winter watering systems if project area is located in targeted areas as identified in the East Souris River or Pembina River Integrated Watershed Management Plans (may include pump, pipe, fittings, trough, tank etc.).

Application deadline: On-going.

Supporting documents: Project map/details must be submitted to the TMCD. (Contact a TMCD staff member to request an aerial photo in order to map and describe your project).

TERMS AND CONDITIONS**General Terms and Conditions:**

- All types of remote watering systems are eligible for assistance including but not limited to solar, wind, gas, animal operated pumps, shallow burial pipeline systems and winter watering systems;
- Replacement materials or regular maintenance costs are ineligible for assistance;
- Landowners that have received assistance from this program since April 1, 2002 will be ineligible for any new projects from this program;
- The annual projects resulting from this program will be subject to funds appropriated;

- The remote watering system must be implemented within the TMCD;
- The annual projects resulting from this program will be subject to funds appropriated; and
- Failure of a landowner/renter to meet Landowner Responsibilities may negate him / her from other Conservation District programs.

TERMS AND CONDITIONS (continued)

Landowner Responsibility:

- Request assistance by the proper application in full, which is to be received at the TMCD office
- Install remote watering system project within the TMCD in the year of application;
- Shall not sell, trade or exchange remote watering system materials for a minimum of 5 years;
- Not alter, change, remove or modify the project without written consent of the District for 5 years;
- Be responsible for reasonable maintenance of the project;
- Provide access for inspection or evaluation by TMCD Staff or Board when requested;
- Consent to the TMCD establishing appropriate signage for the project if desired;

Conservation District Responsibility:

- Notify landowners regarding the approval / disapproval of applications;
- Provide aerial photographs of the project land;
- Provide recommendations on various types of remote watering systems or refer the landowner to the appropriate technical staff to assist with the selection of a suitable remote watering system;
- Inspect the project upon completion;
- Retain the option to erect signage promoting the Remote Watering System Program.

It is understood that this agreement shall indemnify and save harmless the Turtle Mountain Conservation District #4, their agents, engineers, servants and/or employees from any liability which may result from the execution of the project.

I hereby declare that I have read the conditions of the Remote Watering System Program and that I agree to abide by the terms of the policy; and that I agree to co-operate to the fullest extent with the Turtle Mountain Conservation District #4 in completing and maintaining the project as outlined above.
